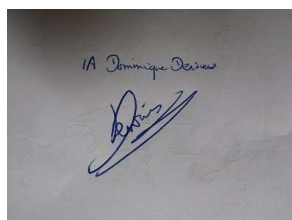
Confidential Report: (Comments of Chief Arbiter, failing that Organizer)
