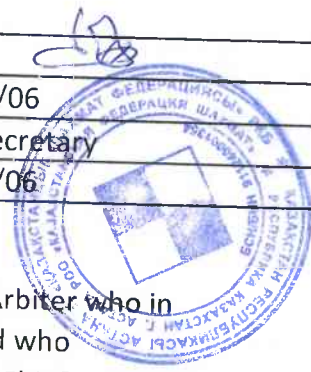
Mr. Yurkov is hardworking Arbiter. He is good at managing playing hall, applying FIDE Laws of Chess and working with electronic clocks.
